Dear SEO,

We are pleased to inform you that the DFSA is launching a Cyber Threat Intelligence Platform (the "Platform") in the DIFC in January 2020.

The purpose of the Platform is to establish a cybersecurity community in the DIFC to facilitate the detection and prevention of cyberattacks through sharing of cyber threat intelligence information. The use of the Platform by DIFC firms is voluntary and at no cost. We have designed the Platform to provide its users with enriched cyber threat intelligence information from multiple sources.

You are invited to an outreach session on **Tuesday 21 January 2020, from 10:00 am to 11:30 am**. The purpose of the outreach session is to introduce the Platform, to discuss the role of participants and users on the Platform, to highlight the main benefits of participating and using the Platform and to address any questions you may have about the function and operation of the Platform.

The outreach session will be held at DFSA's offices. Seating is limited, therefore, pre-registration is required and will be accepted on a first-come basis (registration will close at the end of business on 19 January 2020). The outreach session will also be transmitted via live webcast.
